

LIN101 is the simplest interface between an existing LAN and a serial device.

There are three basic ways to work with the LIN101:

- In Windows OS through virtual serial port. In this case it's possible to run by the same application software already installed that was using a standard COM.
Virtual serial port can be created by VSPD software included in the installation tools provided.
- In both Windows and other OS, running with a software able to manage directly UDP/IP and TCP/IP protocols
- Creating a virtual serial link over the network by using two LIN101 (see 2nd figure).
